Austin and Hope Pilkington Trust Opens for Round 1 Applications

In line with its 2022 focus on the Arts, the Trust's first round gives priority to projects supporting performers and creatives in the early stages of their career and responding directly to the impacts of COVID-19 on the sector.

Registered charities working in the Arts can apply for grants of up to £1,000, providing they have an annual income of between £100,000 and £2 million.

The deadline to apply for this round is 28th February, 2022.

Community Gardens Award Accepting Applications

The Community Gardens Award offers grants for projects run by amateur garden groups with a community focus.

The project should aim to bring a community together by creating a space people can share, by the acquisition and sharing of gardening knowledge and skills and by inspiring a love of gardening.

Funding could cover expenses such as:

- Site preparation (including hire of small mechanical tools such as rotavators).
- Hand tools.
- Plants.
- Trees.
- Shrubs.
- Containers.
- Seating.

There is no fixed minimum or maximum award, but grants do not usually exceed £5,000.

The deadline to apply is 28th February, 2022.
