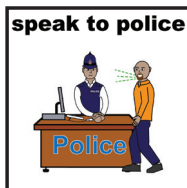

What is Pegasus and who is it for?



Nottinghamshire Police Service want to give extra support to vulnerable people and people who have disabilities to help them keep safe.



You can apply for a Pegasus card from Nottinghamshire Police.

You can give them your details when you apply, so that in an emergency they can quickly help you.



The Pegasus scheme is for people who;

- Find it hard to communicate.
- Have an illness or disability.



When do you use the Pegasus card?



If you are feeling upset or ill, it can be difficult to tell the police what has happened to you.

It could be that you:

- Feel threatened or hurt.
- Someone has stolen something from you.
- You are lost.

How does the Pegasus card work?

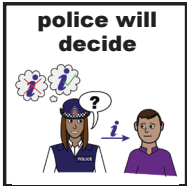
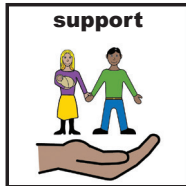


On the phone

Your card will have a number and if you need to call the police.

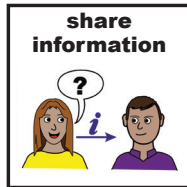
Say “Pegasus” and your number.

Example “Pegasus 6048.”



The number on your card is just for you.

The Pegasus card will help the police find your details quickly.



In the community

You can show your card to a police officer or member of the emergency services, so they know you need extra help and support.

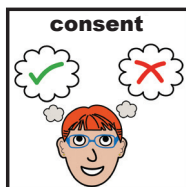

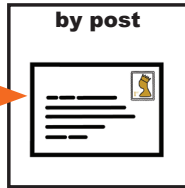
- You do not have to have a card; it is your choice.



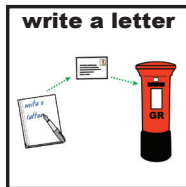
What will the Police need to know?

What will happen next?

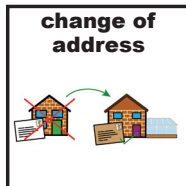


Nottinghamshire Police
will send you a card.

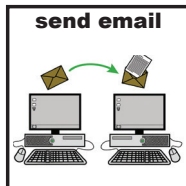


Once a year the police will

information safe.

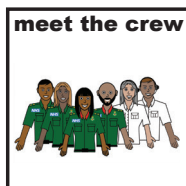
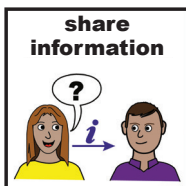


You can change or update your
