Small grants (around £200) will be awarded by a committee of Worksop Rotary members drawn together for the purpose and successful applicants will be judged on the strength of their application against the criteria shown below.

- 3. Briefly tell us what you try to achieve as a group:
- 4. Tell us how the beneficiaries of the group are identified:
- 5. Tell us what you are hoping to buy, pay for or achieve with any grant you receive.
- 6. Tell us as closely as you can what this will cost (how big a grant?).
- 7. Tell us how the grant will be managed and how you will judge the success of its use.

Criteria used to judge the application.

- What impact does this group hope to have on people's welfare in Worksop and District? Are their objectives clear?
- How effective can this small grant be in making an improvement in the work of the group?
- How will the use of the grant be managed/assessed, does the group have a plan?
