The Nottingham Prince's Trust team delivered a special 'Get Started with Empowerment' programme in partnership with Boots and following the programme, proudly marched at the Nottingham Pride parade with our incredible young people.

The programme had 10 young participants over the duration of the programme and parade day, who all identified as either LGBTQIA+ or allies.

The wonderful process to pulling this programme together was reaching out to and collaborating teams within The Prince's Trust, Boots, local partners and local businesses.
