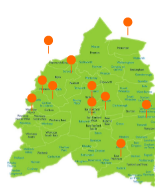

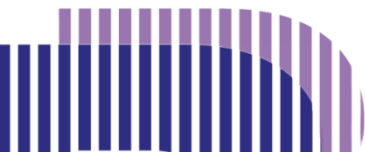

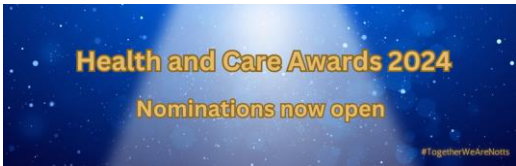

Nominations are open **until 5pm on 27 August** and the winners will be announced at a ceremony held at John Fretwell Sporting Complex on 6 November.

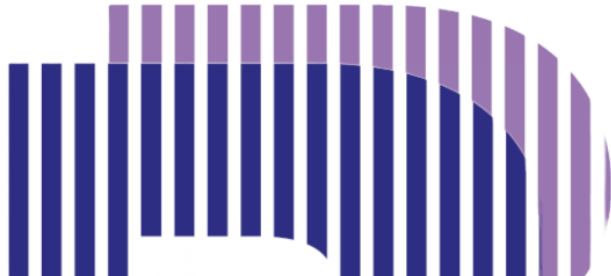
