



For many households healthy foods, especially fruit and vegetables, are unavailable, unaffordable, or inaccessible. Fresh Street is an innovative area/ place based approach designed to support food / public health nutrition policy makers build healthier and fairer local food systems.

Fresh Street – a place based approach

Regular vouchers for fruit and vegetables that can be used with local independent fruit and vegetable retailers.

UK fruit and vegetable consumption continues to be below the recommended 5-a-day. Despite national healthy eating information campaigns, and support for families on low incomes on benefits (Healthy Start), just 20% of the UK population eat the recommended 5 daily portions of fresh fruit and vegetables.



Adult students are eligible to have their courses fully funded if they are:

- . Students must be 19+ born on or before 31st August 2005 to be eligible for funding
- on certain benefits (Universal Credit take home pay less than £617 per month for a single claim or £988 per month for a joint claim, Jobseekers Allowance including National insurance Credits only, Employment Support Allowance, Other state benefits if take home pay is less than £67 per month for a single claim or £988 per month for a joint claim AND the student states at enrolment that they are looking
- if gross annual salary is less than: £25,000 for residents who live in Derbyshire or Nottinghamshire











Worried about money this Winter?

Make sure you're claiming the benefits and energy savings you're entitled to.

Drop into **Aurora (Old Worksop Library)** on **Thursday 17th October** from **9.30am - 3pm** to find out what you may be able to claim.

Citizens Advice can do a free eligibility check for benefits including Attendance Allowance and Pension Credit, which may mean you're entitled to the Winter Fuel Payment

On the day, please bring

- 1. Information about any income, savings and investments you have
- 2. Your bank account details



Come along and see us. No appointment necessary.


