*Decline in food supply- Fareshare supply is moving towards catering packs / frozen-untapped supply route to groups and capacity to break into manageable size packs plus labelling. This is capacity intensive for groups; Liaising with companies to ensure supply gets into localities. This is in competition with Fareshare who approach local companies for donations. Action Need to co-ordinate with Fareshare to enable local groups to access from local companies.  Feeding Britain are running two webinars in early 2025 which might be relevant to food	ALL KH
